Learn to Skate Classes

Snowplow Sam: designed to help children ages four-six develop strength and coordination while learning skating fundamentals.

Basic Skills: an introduction to skating fundamentals including forward and backward skating, stops, edges crossovers turns and Mohawks.

Fast Track to Figure Skating (Basic 4 and up): a basic introduction to figure skating, including jumps, spins, moves in the field. Skate twice a week to speed your progress. Fast Track Adults 1-6 (ages 16 and up): quickly move from the basics, then join Adult Academy

WIA Academy (Pre-Free Skate & up): advanced work on jumps, spins & artistry on ice

Moves in the Field (Basic 6 and up): develop greater edge control, power and extension Adult Academy (Age 16 and up): begin working on jumps, spins, edge improvement Off-ice (Fast Track and WIA Academy skaters only): cardio, core and flexibility, jump techniques are the focus

Learn to Skate USA Membership

- Annual fee is \$16 plus \$1.25 processing and handling, regardless of when skater is enrolled, and includes secondary sports accident insurance.

- Tuition must be paid in advance. No payment plans, credits or refunds.
