Class Descriptions

Learn to Skate Classes

Snowplow Sam: designed to help children ages four-six develop strength and coordination while learning skating fundamentals.

Basic Skills: an introduction to skating fundamentals including forward and backward skating, stops, edges crossovers turns and Mohawks.

Fast Track to Figure Skating (Basic 5-6): a basic introduction to figure skating, including jumps, spins, moves in the field. You'll skate twice a week to speed your progress.

Fast Track Adults 1-6 (ages 15 and up): quickly move from the basics, then join Adult Academy. Twice is nice! Pick two days to Fast Track your progress.

Junior Academy: a basic introduction to figure skating. You can even skate twice a week to speed your progress.

Pre-Free Skate (Basic Skills 7-8): Waltz jump, one-foot spins, edge work will transition skaters to the WIA Academy

WIA Academy (Free Skate 1 and up): advanced work on jumps, spins & artistry on ice. Perfect your moves, jumps and spins: skate twice each week!

Adult Academy (Age 15 and up): begin working on jumps, spins, edge improvement.

Off-ice (Pre-Free Skate, Junior/WIA/Adult Academy): cardio, core and flexibility, jump techniques are the focus.

Parent and Me: Learn to skate with your little ones, ages two-three (parents must have prior skating experience).

Learn to Play Hockey Classes

Beginner/Intermediate: skaters aged four and up learn basic skating skills and preliminary stick and puck handling, plus a scrimmage.

Elite: hockey drills, stick and puck handling techniques, skating skills, plus a scrimmage

Synchronized skating is a team sport with eight to 20 skaters performing choreographed elements and footwork as a unit over the ice. We'll take you through the basics, including of speed precision, unison, and formations.

Some Things to Know

- The Learn to Skate program offers classes for skaters ages two and up. Youth Hockey begins at age four.
- Our program is designed to teach the fundamentals of skating in a supportive and enjoyable environment.
- Group classes run in six, seven or eight-week semesters.
- Our professional staff will evaluate skaters throughout each semester. This will ensure that everyone is initially in the correct class and will determine if required elements for that semester have been mastered for promotion to the next level.
- Some levels are more difficult than others and may take more than one semester to complete.

What to Wear

- Dress in comfortable layers that allow for unrestricted movement. Jeans are not recommended.
- A helmet (bicycle or ski) is required to be worn by all skaters registered for Snowplow 1-4, Basic Skills 1-4 and all skaters 10 and under. Admission to the ice for class without a helmet is not permitted.
- Gloves for warmth and thin socks that rise above the ankle

LEARN TO SKATE USA

Learn to Skate USA Membership

- All Learn to Skate class participants must be current members of Learn To Skate USA. All participants must register/renew each year at learntoskateusa.com. Membership runs from 7/1-6/30 in any given year.
- Skaters not permitted on the ice without current Learn To Skate USA membership.
- Annual fee is \$17 plus \$1.50 processing and handling, regardless of when skater is enrolled, and includes secondary sports accident insurance.

Terms and Conditions

- *Class registration is online only.* Go to worldice.com to set up an account.
- Tuition must be paid in advance. No payment plans, credits or refunds.
- \$15 late fee with registration submitted after stated deadline. Same day walk-in or call-in registration not permitted.
- Parents permitted on the ice only with Parent and Me registration.
- Missed classes, activities, reservations or sessions of any kind (including due to COVID-19 and/or quarantining) cannot be transferred to another session, rescheduled, credited or refunded for any reason unless cancelled by World Ice Arena. Your registration guarantees you a space in the class regardless of your attendance. No Exceptions.
- World Ice Arena reserves the right to change or cancel the day or time of any given class.
- Maximum 10-12 students per class. Levels may be combined if fewer than three skaters are registered for a given class.
- Name tags will be given to, and must be worn by, all registered class participants during each class. A \$5 fee will be charged for all lost or forgotten name tags.
